- Determine requirements for spare parts and equipment in coordination with the procurement department.
- Optimise the management of technical stock (critical parts, minimum and maximum levels).
- Draw up maintenance budgets and investment forecasts.
- Contribute to the equipment renewal policy.
- Work closely with the production, logistics and procurement teams.
